

ECKINGTON WITCH – BOOK FOLDING

When choosing a book, you ideally need to use 160 pages (ie 80 leaves). This will give you a good firm sculpture. You can get away with less and in particular the hedgehog is quite flexible on this. However, with the angel, you have to remember she needs to stand up.

When preparing the book, you may need to use a craft knife or Stanley knife to cut the book but do be careful and make sure your fingers are not in the way; it's very easy to slip!

HEDGEHOG:

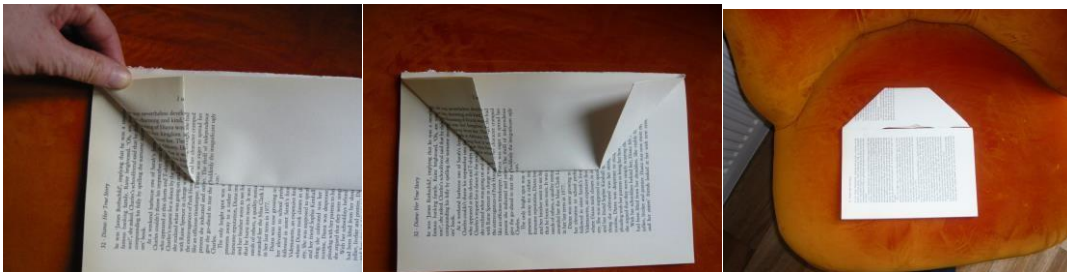
Place the prepared book down with the spine facing away from you.

Take the first page and fold in half towards the spine, and crease the fold

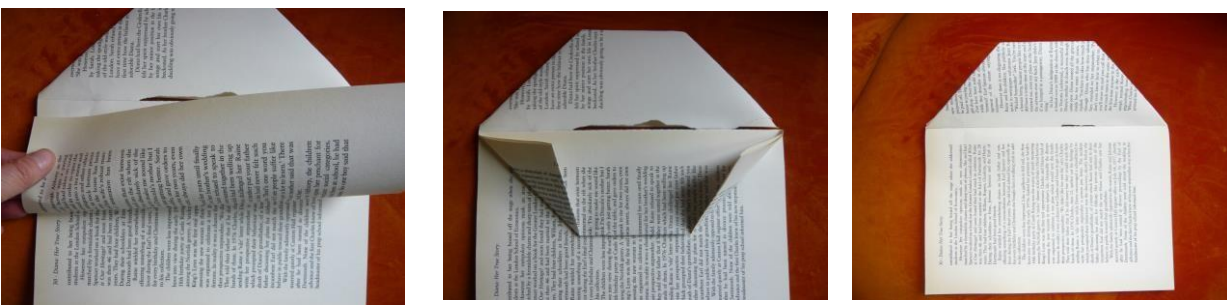


Then take one of the corners of the folded page and fold that towards the spine. Do the same with the other corner.

Once both corners folded towards the spine, turn the page over to the top.



Then begin again by folding the next page towards the spine. fold in both corners again towards the spine, & turn page again to the top. Repeat until all pages completed -

Use buttons and glue on to make eyes and nose.
